

Ōpito Bay Community Guidelines

The Residents and Ratepayers of beautiful Ōpito Bay respect the rights and freedoms of others to enjoy this special place but remind everyone of their collective responsibilities to comply with all bylaws and local “good community practices”.

- Be conversant and comply with all current Fisheries rules
- **DO NOT** dispose of fish bodies and offal on the beach
- Motorised vehicles are permitted on this beach only for launching and retrieving of boats
- **DO NOT** leave glass and bottles on the beach
- Alcohol is generally forbidden in public places
- Dogs Owners please be responsible about your dog’s behaviour and do observe the TCDC bylaws which are rigidly enforced at this beach
- **DO NOT** permit underage & unlicensed drivers on this public beach - it is considered a road and thus road rules apply
- Dispose of all household rubbish responsibly in the kerbside collection or by taking it to the Transfer Station at Matarangi or Whitianga
- Check your boat and have all safety items on board
- Don’t swim in the boat launching area
- Personal Water Craft must be operated 200m off the beach or at 5km or less when closer than 200m
